## *Sher's Jalapeno-Lime Slaw*

1 bag slaw mix, coarsely chopped

1 jalapeno, seeded and chopped (if not hot enough for ya add some Frank's red hot pepper sauce. I do)

1 scallion, sliced thin, salt & pepper to taste

zest & juice 1 to 1 1/2 limes, depending on size

1/4 cup sour cream, 1/4 cup mayonnaise,  
2 tsp Gulden's spicy brown mustard

3 packets Splenda OR 1 Tbsp sugar

Combine slaw mix, salt, pepper and lime zest and juice and toss.

Whisk together remaining ingredients and stir into slaw mix until well mixed.

Chill.

\* Note: I created this recipe because, for health reasons, I am on a very restricted low salt diet. My answer is to use spicy ingredients. I do, however use a smidge of salt and the salt I use is pink Himalayan salt (in a grinder) which has a bit of a different flavor than table salt but contains many trace minerals not found in table salt. IF you use table salt, I think the recipe will taste good nonetheless. Enjoy.
