Pentecost Sunday

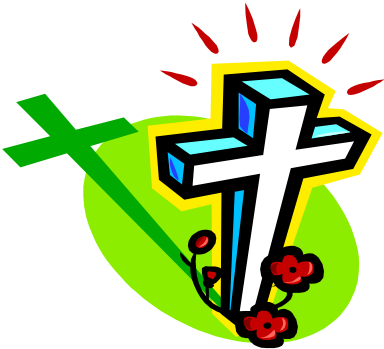
When the Feast of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Without warning there was a sound like a strong wind, gale force—no one could tell where it came from. It filled the whole building. Then, like a wildfire, the Holy Spirit spread through their ranks, and they started speaking in a number of different languages as the Spirit prompted them.

The Christian holiday of Pentecost is celebrated on the seventh Sunday (49 days) after Easter. It commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks, as described in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2:1-31). Since its date depends on the date of Easter, Pentecost is a moveable feast. This year Pentecost Sunday falls on May 20th. Please help us celebrate by wearing red to our worship service.
